

Admission Policy for Ph.D. Program

Seacom Skills University's Ph.D. admission policy includes several key criteria:

1. **Eligibility:** Applicants shall hold a Master's degree in a relevant discipline with at least 55% aggregate marks or equivalent grade. For candidates from reserved categories, the minimum is typically 50% or as per UGC norms.
2. **Entrance Examination:** Prospective students shall clear the Seacom Skills University Research Entrance Test (SSU-RET) or qualify through national-level exams like UGC-NET, CSIR-NET, or GATE. Successful candidates shall have appeared to an interview where research proposals and academic backgrounds will be evaluated.
3. **Application Process:** Candidates need to submit an online or offline application, including necessary documents like educational certificates, research proposal, and identity proofs. The university will announce admissions annually, and deadlines shall be specified on their official website and advertisements.
4. **Course Structure:** The Ph.D. program involves coursework, seminars, and extensive research. Students are encouraged to publish their work in reputed journals, and the university offers regular workshops to support research activities.
